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BEING KNOWN AS CHRISTIANS

• Jesus' followers were first called <u>His disciples</u>.

MATTHEW 5:1

And seeing the multitudes, He went up on a mountain, and when He was seated His disciples came to Him.

MARK 2:15b

....many tax collectors and sinners also sat together with Jesus and His disciples; for there were many, and they followed Him.

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The two disciples heard him speak, and they followed Jesus.

• Then they were known as being of the Way.

ACTS 9:2b

....so that if he found any who were of the Way, whether men or women, he might bring them bound to Jerusalem.

Jesus had declared Himself to be the Way.

JOHN 14:6*b* "I am the way, the truth, and the life. No one comes to the Father except through Me."

• Their enemies did not speak well of the Way.

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But when some were hardened and did not believe, but spoke evil of the Way before the multitude, he departed from them and withdrew the disciples,...

23*b*there arose a great commotion about the Way.

• They were first called Christians in Antioch.

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Peter taught that if we suffer as a Christian, it is our honor and reason to praise the Lord.

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Yet if *anyone suffers* as a Christian, let him not be ashamed, but let him glorify God in this matter. **NKJV**

(NLT)_But it is no shame to suffer for being a Christian. Praise God for the privilege of being called by his name!

(ASV)_....glorify God in this name.
