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DON'T FORGET THE GOSPEL!

QUESTION: Unlike other cities, Paul did not make very many converts in Athens. Why?

ANSWER: Compare his preaching in Athens with his very different preaching in Corinth.

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POINT: While being relevant is important, doing so should never reduce the gospel.

THE GOSPEL IS -

Not to be diluted.

1 CORINTHIANS 1 ¹⁷ For Christ did not send me to baptize but to preach the gospel, not with wisdom of words, lest the cross of Christ should be made of no effect.

Perceived as foolishness.

¹⁸ For the message of the cross is foolishness to those who are perishing, but to us who are being saved it is the power of God......

- The power of God.
- · What God uses to save us.

For since, in the wisdom of God, the world through wisdom did not know God, it pleased God through the foolishness of the message preached to save those who believe.

What God uses to humble us.

For Jews request a sign, and Greeks seek after wisdom; but we preach Christ crucified, to the Jews a stumbling block and to the Greeks foolishness, but to those who are called, both Jews and Greeks, Christ the power of God and the wisdom of God. Because the foolishness of God is wiser than men, and the weakness of God is stronger than men.

Not easily seen by unbelievers.

2 CORINTHIANS 4 ³ But even if our gospel is veiled, it is veiled to those who are perishing, ⁴ whose minds the god of this age has blinded, who do not believe, lest the light of the gospel of the glory of Christ, who is the image of God, should shine on them.

To be kept <u>pure</u>.

GALATIANS 1 ⁶ I marvel that you are turning away so soon from Him who called you in the grace of Christ, to a different gospel, ⁷ which is not another; but there are some who trouble you and want to pervert the gospel of Christ.

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
